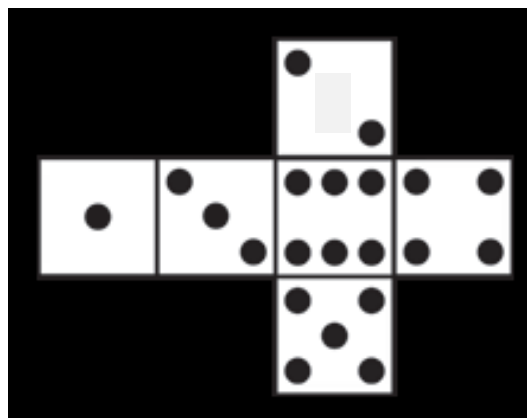


# DIY Yard Dice



## Supplies:

- Approximately 20" of 4x4 wood, cut into 5 cubes (actual size is 3.5"x3.5")
- Sand paper or electric sander
- Paint – we'll use outdoor acrylic paint
- Foam paint brush
- Circular foam stamper for painting dots
- Poly urethane sealer or acrylic sealer spray (if using regular acrylic paint)
- Die template or dice to use as guide for painting dots(pips)

## Instructions:

1. Sand all sides and the corners of each block to ensure they are smooth and free of splinters.
2. Apply two thin coats of paint to all sides of the blocks, allowing time to dry between coats.



3. Using the die template or die as a guide, paint the dots on your blocks using the circular foam stamper. (We recommend painting all 5 dice at once to help make it easier to ensure you're painting the sides in the right order.)



4. Allow blocks to dry fully.
5. If using regular acrylic paint, apply a thin coat of sealer to the blocks.

Store your blocks in a large sand pail or 5-gallon bucket; this can double as your shaker.
