

Alcohol Ink Tile Coasters

Supplies:

- Ceramic tiles (2)
- Alcohol ink in at least 2 colors
- Rubbing alcohol
- Paint brush
- Clear acrylic spray
- Felt piece
- Newspaper to cover work area

Basic Alcohol Ink Instructions:

1. Cover work area with newspaper. Wear old clothes. Consider wearing disposable gloves.
2. Using a paint brush, dab the alcohol all over the shiny surface of the ceramic tile. The more alcohol on the tile, the more the inks will blend together.
3. Drop some alcohol ink directly onto the alcohol covered tile.
4. Wait...and watch...as the alcohol inks begin to move and blend together. If you notice the inks are not spreading and white parts are still showing, you can add a little more ink to that area or help it spread by blowing gently on the surface. Be careful not to mix the colors too much.



**Experiment! Adding more alcohol on top of the ink will dilute the color. Sprinkle alcohol to create speckles. Layer ink on top of other colors.



4. When the tile is dry, apply a coat of clear acrylic spray to seal it.
5. Let tile dry completely. Then attach a square of felt to the bottom of the tile to turn it into a coaster.
