**Rules:**

- This contest is open to teens who will be entering grades 7-12 in the 2021-2022 school year.
- Each participant may submit a maximum of one photo per category.
- Photos must be taken by the participant.
- Subjects must be appropriate for public display.
- All submissions must be submitted to the library by July 31 in order to be considered for prizes.
- By entering the contest, you understand that your photo may be used to promote and publicize future library photo contests or the library itself.

**Categories:**

- **People**
  - Can include portraits, photos of people in action, etc.
  - *Please ask your subject(s) for their consent before submitting the photo.*
- **Architecture**
  - Can include buildings, bridges, structures, etc.
- **Nature**
  - Can include the general outdoors, animals, flowers, weather, etc.
- **Macro Photography**
  - Can include close-up photographs of any subject
- **Still Life**
  - Can include anything that might not fall neatly into the above categories

**How to Enter:**

Photos may be submitted via email to [info@phpl.lib.wi.us](mailto:info@phpl.lib.wi.us) in an acceptable image file type (.jpg, .png or .tif). Each participant must include the following information with their submission(s):

- Name, grade, and phone number
- Photo category

**Judging:**

Each photo will be judged for impact, composition and quality of lighting by a panel of judges. Winners will be selected for each category by a panel of judges, and one photograph will be selected to win Best in Show. Winning photographs will be displayed within the Library and along Main Street as conditions allow.
